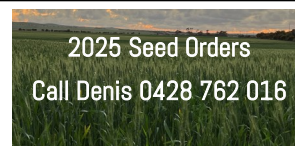

A few facts about **Haemonchus Contortus** (the **Barbers Pole worm**) and effective control.

.....and did you know why it's called the "Barbers Pole" worm?.....

What is different about Barbers pole compared to the other round worms?

- Feeds off blood in the abomasum (stomach).
- Most fecund of all round worms – each adult female produces around 10 000 eggs per day – which are excreted in faeces.
- Fastest pre-patent period (time from being laid as an egg to becoming an adult worm). Prefers higher temperatures to complete life cycle.



What are the ideal conditions for Barbers Pole?

- Warm, wet and humid.
- These conditions trigger eggs on the pasture to hatch & develop into infective larvae that are then consumed by grazing stock.

Many areas in eastern Australia that have received summer rainfall this year will be providing ideal conditions for Barbers Pole to thrive!

Clinical signs in animals infected with Barbers Pole:

- Anaemia (because BP worms feed on blood) = pale mucous membranes (gums) are a sign of a significant infection.
- Exercise intolerance: having a large tail in the mob, significantly infected animals may fall over quickly when mustered.
- Bottle Jaw - Blood loss from Barbers Pole feeding also depletes the animals of vital protein - this leads to fluid accumulation in areas including under the jaw, front legs and abdomen.
- Manure is often dry and scant, sometimes dark, due to presence of melena (digested blood).
- Sudden death.

Monitoring:

- Worm Egg counts are a simple and effective tool farmers can use to monitor for Barbers Pole. Often waiting until clinical signs have appeared can risk significant stock losses/deaths if stock are infected with Barbers Pole.

Effective Drenching:

- Barbers Pole's ability to reproduce in large numbers quickly means it can often develop resistance to many commonly used drench chemicals.
