Seed Germination Testing

The quality of your seed that is saved at harvest depends on a number of things, including stress events that occur with your crop during the year, like high temperatures during flowering, moisture stress, even below optimum nitrogen levels can influence protein, germination and screenings. Last season was particularly challenging with a few of these factors, and the quality of your seed that you plant for next years crop, will determine what you harvest.

You with get a complete germination analysis that will take the guess work out of determining sowing rates for next years crops. Adjusting your sowing rate according to germination percentage can be one of the most economical decisions to make to get the best yields.

This seed testing service is provided by Seed Services Australia to seed growers, companies, processors, resellers, importers, exporters, research institutes, universities, and the farming community.
